

START THE FEATHERED FESTIVITIES!

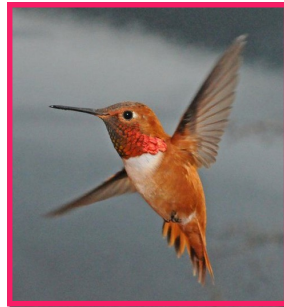
You've been learning to move and sing like a bird all week, so now it's time to celebrate!

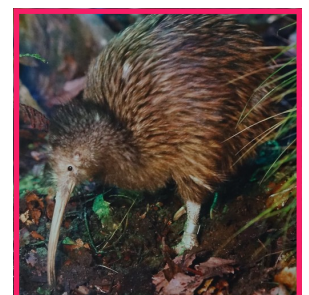
