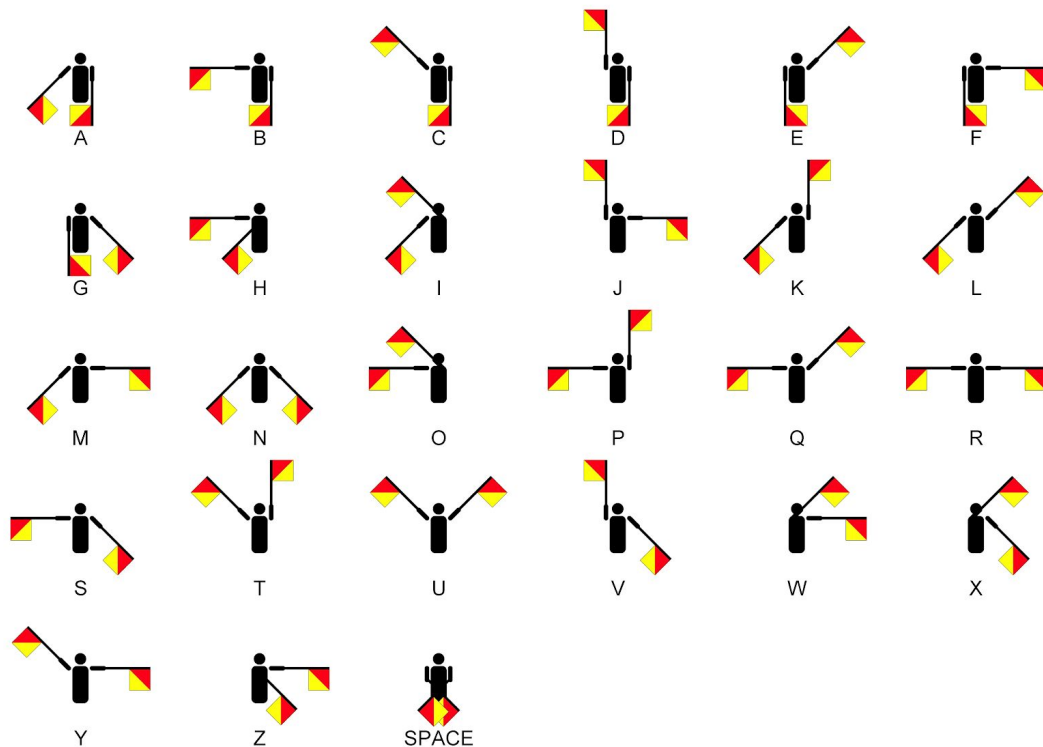


CODE DRAWINGS!
