We then head indoors for a creative workshop led by a different guest artist each month, curated by Matipo Arts - that's where you come in.

As the guest artist, you will deliver a 45 minute creative activity, forming the second half of one of the Walk, Talk, Do, Care monthly sessions. This activity should be accessible, and appealing to those who don't view themselves as "creative".
